PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

A \$75.00 non-refundable administrative and inspection fee will be charged for all Applications to Excavate a Highway.

A cash bond is required for all applications. At the Town's sole discretion, the Town may allow a surety bond for projects valued over \$20,000.

A Performance Bond, guaranteed for five years, is required for applications of work valued at \$20,000.00 or greater.

The Town shall hold the bond for one-year after the satisfactory installation of the permanent pavement repair. With proper notification resulting in adequate inspections and Town satisfaction with the work, the Town may elect to release a portion of the bond at the completion of the permanent pavement restoration. Release of a portion of the bond prior to one-year after the satisfactory installation of the permanent pavement repair is at the Town's sole discretion.

Failure to obtain the necessary inspections from the Town or failure to properly notify the Town of work may result in the Town maintaining possession of the bond for up to five years from the date of completion. Inspections shall include, but not be limited to, backfilling, compacting, paving, curb setting, and curb lock placement.

One (1) set of plans, a Certificate of Insurance with the Town listed as additionally insured, and a copy of the RI Contractors Registration must be submitted with this Application. Copies of NBC and/or RIDOT PAP Permits must be submitted with this Application when applicable. At minimum, plans shall depict proposed work with dimensions, edges of pavement, property lines, visible structures, utility poles, utility structures, and a north arrow.

Granite Curbs. All replaced or installed curbing must be granite unless otherwise permitted by the Town. Curbing must be installed with concrete curb lock in accordance with the Town of Lincoln Curb Lock Detail.

Temporary pavement patch must be installed within 24 hours.

Permanent pavement repair shall be installed no less than 6 months after excavation and no later 12 months.

The Contractor shall be responsible for any settlement or pooling of water that may occur as a result of the work included in this application for five years after the approved permanent pavement repair.

The Contractor shall be responsible for any pavement repair that may occur as a result of the work included in this application for five years after the approved permanent pavement repair.

The Contractor shall respond to all trench restoration requests by the Town of Lincoln within 48 hours.

The Contractor shall comply with all Terms and Conditions issued with the Excavation Permit.

Excavations within newly paved roads (less than five years old) are permitted on a case by case basis with special conditions including, but not limited to, full width permanent pavement repair for a length determined by the Town and infrared asphalt treatment at edges.

For further information regarding construction in the Town R.O.W., refer to Sections 24, 25 & 26 in the Town of Lincoln Land Development and Subdivision Regulations.

All work in and upon said highway is to be done under and in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Town of Lincoln and in accordance with the Town Ordinances, particularly Chapter 220, Article II, section 220-4.

All work shall comply with the current edition, including all addenda, of the RIDOT Standard Specifications for Road & Bridge Construction.

The Applicant and Contractor shall indemnify and hold the Town harmless from all damages arising in any way by reason of the excavation work.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

By signing below, the Applicant and the Contractor guarantees all work performed under this permit against settlement for a period of five years; certifies that they will comply with all Terms and Conditions issued in the Excavation Permit; and guarantees they will resolve any nuisance or public safety hazards within 48 hours. Non-response within the specified time may result in the required restoration work being done by the Town, with all expense to be paid by the Applicant.
