Lincoln Tax Assessor, Elaine Mondillo reminds property owners that April 15th is the deadline to file for property tax exemptions. She said “The Town offers taxpayer’s nine exemptions, each with specific eligibility requirements. I want to make sure no one misses our deadline”

The exemptions that are offered are as follows:

- Senior Citizens (must be 65 and a Lincoln resident for 5 Years)
- Senior Citizen Tax Deferment
- Blind
- Homestead Exemption
- Veterans/Widow or Widower of Veterans
- 100 % Disabled Veterans
- Prisoner of War
- Gold Star Parent
- Special Housing

Ms. Mondillo stated, “Employees in the assessor’s department would be happy to speak with anyone who has questions about any exemptions, including questions regarding eligibility and/or criteria.” She added, “Anyone who needs information or help with the application process should call 333-8449.”
