

District One Sewer Appeals Board: The Sewer Appeals Board is a panel of five residents who are responsible for ruling on sewer-related fee appeals from home and business owners.

District One Tenants Board: The Tenants Board is a panel of 7 residents who are responsible for advising the Lincoln Housing Authority on matters concerning the general welfare of the tenants of the town's public housing facilities. The Lincoln Housing Authority owns two Elderly & Disabled facilities, one in Lonsdale and one in Manville, and a small family housing development in Saylesville. The board is also responsible for reviewing (and potentially vetoing) rules of the Housing Authority promulgated by its Board of Commissioners in accordance with Rhode Island General Law 45-25-18.1. The board is further charged with meeting on a regular basis with available federal, state, and local government officials to propose and develop specific legislation designed to alleviate the problems of those tenants living on fixed or limited incomes and to transmit all proposals to the appropriate government representatives for consideration.
