



Town of Lincoln is offering a free public H1N1 vaccination clinic

The Town of Lincoln working with the Rhode Island Department of Health will offer a free public H1N1 vaccination clinic on Saturday January 23, 2010. This clinic will be held at Lincoln High School located at 135 Old River Road and will run from 10:00 AM until 2:00 PM.

This clinic will be open to anyone 18 years of age or older (children younger than 18 are not eligible to be vaccinated at this clinic). The vaccination is free and requires no identification. All participants will be asked to sign a consent form to receive the H1N1 vaccine.

The H1N1 flu season is not over and many Rhode Islanders are still at risk for serious illness from H1N1 flu. Even if you think you may have had the flu, it is still important to receive the H1N1 vaccine.
