**Re: Resurfacing of Angel Road**

Town Administrator, T. Joseph Almond is pleased to announce that starting at 7:00 am Monday, September 13, 2010 – through - 5:00 pm Friday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010, Angel Road in Lincoln will be resurfaced from its intersection with Twin River Road, south to the North Providence town line. This work is being performed with funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and Capital Improvement funds from the Town of Lincoln. Only local traffic will be permitted during construction and the road will be closed to all other through traffic.

Almond stated, “The Angel Road repairs represent the anticipated implementation of over a combined 1.5 million in FEMA flood reimbursement, ARRC stimulus, and Town of Lincoln funding to make much needed road repairs throughout the Town of Lincoln. “

Work is also expected to begin soon on Wilber Rd, Cullen Hill Rd, and Anna Sayles Rd. Additional repaving, drain repair, patching, and sealing, will be conducted throughout the fall and spring seasons.
