

The Town of Lincoln sponsored a FREE MED-POD Tdap (Pertussis) and Flu vaccination clinic on March 10th at the Lincoln High School. The clinic was sponsored in conjunction with the State of RI, the Wellness Company who administered the vaccines, and volunteers from the Town who set up and ran the clinic. Free vaccine was administered to 39 people, who were vaccinated against Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Tetanus, Diphtheria, and the Flu. The Town would like to thank all of the people who attended this clinic to help prevent the spread of Pertussis to the children in our community. The Town of Barrington had several children exposed to this disease which can be fatal to very young children. The Town also wishes to thank all the people who volunteered their time to set up and run the clinic.
