The Lincoln Town Council will be convening a special meeting on Thursday October 4, 2012 at 7:00PM in the Town Council Chambers to hear a presentation from Twin River regarding the November 6, 2012 ballot referendum to allow for the addition of table gaming at Twin River.

At the August 21, 2012 Council meeting, the Town Council unanimously agreed that we, as a Council, should take action that can help inform our citizens about this important issue, and we also unanimously agreed that the best way to accomplish this would be to convene a special Town Council meeting. The Town Council has requested that the Town Administrator, the Chief of Police, the Finance Director and the Principals from Twin River be available to respond to any questions residents may have related to any impact this referendum could have on them or the Town as a whole.

It is our hope that any Lincoln resident who has questions, or would like to gain additional information about this issue, will attend this meeting. As your Town Council it is our objective to promote transparency, invite public discourse, and provide essential information to Lincoln residents in deliberating this important issue.
