

LINCOLN – The Lincoln High School Renovation Committee has launched a comprehensive website to share information about the high school renovation project with the community. The microsite, <http://renovation.lincolnps.org>, will deliver updates on renovating the 61 year old school as well as provide reports, documentation, and architectural renderings as the renovation plan moves forward.

“This renovation will be a project the entire town can be proud of,” said Georgia Fortunato, superintendent of Lincoln Public Schools. “The new website will help keep the public informed and give them a transparent look into how the project is developing.”

The Lincoln High School Renovation Committee is composed of town and school officials, town council and school committee members, and parents. Work to date includes documenting all aspects of the building, including roofing, electrical, entrances and exits, heating, flooring, accessibility, educational programming, traffic patterns, parking space, perimeter fencing, doors, windows, and ventilation. Two public presentations on the architectural analysis of the building are scheduled to gain insight from the community at large, and to inform the public of the findings and recommendations by the planning team. The first public meeting will be held on January 14th at 6:30 p.m. at Lincoln High School. The second meeting will be held February 4th at 6:30 p.m. at Lincoln High School.
