Play provides for creativity, along with social, physical, and emotional well being. "Parks & Rec" offers a supervised Playground program for youngsters in grades 1-8 at the 6 major parks Monday to Friday beginning July 5th and ending August 12th (check times, sites, and schedules on this page). You are encouraged to send your young ones "outside to play" at the park closest to your home.

While most parents choose to have their children stay for the duration of the program's day, after registering, the children are free to enter and leave the park program on their own volition. We do require that the youngsters consult with a staff person and provide exiting information before leaving. It is very important to all parties concerned, that the parents who want their children to stay in the program all day, should stress this to their children. The children should treat each other with respect . Harassment or bullying will not be tolerated. All participants must **ABIDE BY ALL PARK RULES**, as well as the **enforcement of the rules by the Parks and Recreation Staff.** I also fully understand that my child's failure to do so will lead to disciplinary action that may include dismissal from the program for the day, or for the remainder of the program of which I will be informed. I also understand that if the situation calls for it I will be contacted to come to the park to remove said child . Also, in case of accident or serious illness, I request the Recreation Staff to contact me. If the Recreation Staff is unable to contact me, the Staff may take whatever measures deemed necessary including calling paramedics for emergency care.
